Tasting Notes:

FUN! Explosive aromas of nectarine, pear and grape, honey and frangipani. Gently sweet with a little spritz, the freshness of the wine is important in keeping it light and balanced.

Production Notes:

100% Muscat Blanc a Petits Grains

From Portia Valley Wines' vineyards, sandy loam over clay. Made as a classic Moscato with such a pretty pink color. Stainless steel ferment and aging, no oak. Bottled young. Sterile fining and filtration before bottling. 7% abv. 90g/L residual sugar. 2,000 cases made.
